

Vermont PRAMS Data Brief

Oral Health – Part 2

This is a report on the Pregnancy Risk Assessment Monitoring System (PRAMS), a survey conducted on a sample of Vermont women with live births since 2001. Oral Health Part 1 reported on 2009-2010 Oral Health indicators such as cleanings before pregnancy, dental checkups oral health care advice.

This report combines the following two questions to measure the timing of the respondent's dental care:

*At any time during the **12 months before** you got pregnant with your new baby, did you have your teeth cleaned by a dentist or dental hygienist? (Y/N)*

*During your **most recent** pregnancy did you go to a dentist or dental clinic? (Y/N).*

Complete question wording is found at the end of this report.

Dental Care before and during pregnancy

- Nearly two thirds (65 %) of mothers reported getting their teeth cleaned by a dentist or dental hygienist in the year before they got pregnant.
- Nearly as many (61 %) went to a dentist or a dental clinic during their most recent pregnancy.
- Combining the responses to these two questions yields the following results:

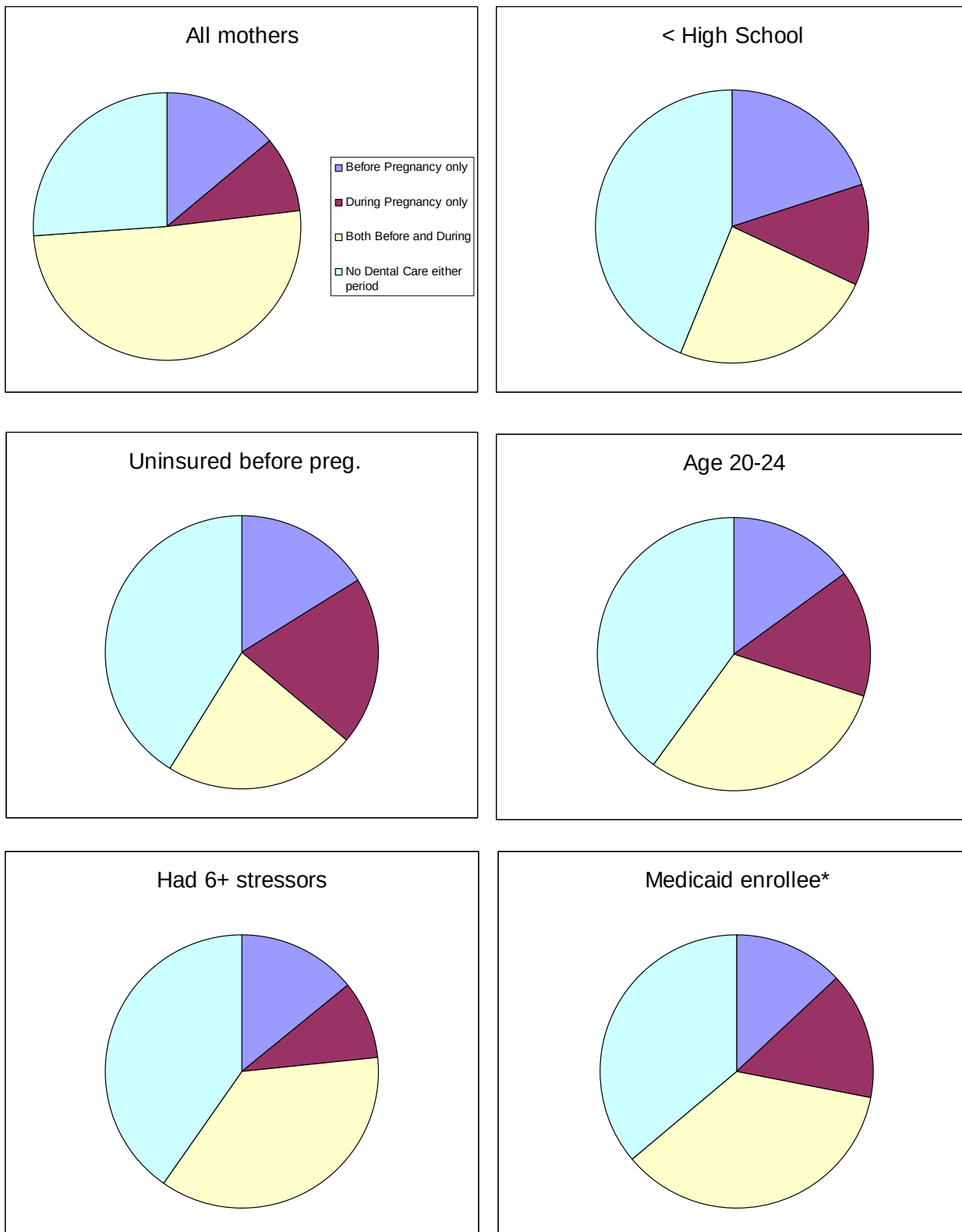
Received dental care in the year before pregnancy only	14%
Received dental care during pregnancy only	9%
Received dental care both before and during pregnancy	51%
Did not get dental care during either time period	26%
- As shown in the table below, the proportion without dental care at either time is higher among certain groups. For example, among those who have not obtained a high school degree that percentage is 44%. It is also higher among the uninsured, those in their early twenties, and those who reported 6 or more stressful events during their pregnancy.
- There are lower levels of dental care 'both before and during pregnancy' for these groups – ranging from 24 to 36 % – as compared to 51% for all mothers.
